



## Policyholder Request to Add/Delete Self-Administrator

A policyholder can designate one or more administrators to manage all of the *Texas Mutual*<sup>®</sup> online accounts for their organization. A policyholder administrator can:

- Create new user accounts
- Remove user accounts
- Reset passwords
- Change user contact information (i.e. email addresses)
- Change user access privileges
- Review account maintenance activities via online reports
